



## AS/A Level Admission Policy

1. Admissions to Grade 11 are open from December each year.
2. All enrollment should be completed before 25th January each year.
3. The academic session for AS Level will start in February each year.
4. Each student enrolled for AS Level has to opt from 4 subjects.
5. To offer a subject, there must be at least 4 students opting the subject.
6. English will be compulsory for all students. Option of going for AS or A Level is available in English.
7. Apart from English, each student has to opt for 3 subjects from each group. (Appendix 1)
8. A student enrolling for AS Level subject should have studied that subject in IGCSE/ O Levels and must have achieved at least a C in the subject.
9. Billabong High International School follows a 'staged' assessment route – take the Cambridge International AS Level in one examination series (Grade 11) and complete the final Cambridge International A Level at a subsequent series (Grade 12).
10. A student will only be allowed to attempt for A Levels if he/she has achieved a D in that particular subject at AS Level. In case the student has not achieved the minimum requirement the student will have to stop at AS Level only for that particular subject. Though the student will have the option to improve the results by resitting the same examination in the next year. For example, a student appears for AS Level subject in November and could not perform as per expectation, then he/she can appear for the same subject (AS) in November next year. He/she will not be allowed to reappear in May/June series.
11. It is the discretion of a student if he/she wants to reappear for an AS Level subject to improve the results. The student is solely responsible for preparing for this subject. Normal classes will not be disrupted to provide support to the child. However, the teachers always welcome to provide support to the student outside the regular class timings.
12. **Attendance** is an important criteria for a student to be allowed to sit for AS/A Level examination. The school will **not allow** a student to appear for an examination if he/she fails to achieve 80% attendance during the academic year.
